3. Decriminalisation of Parking Enforcement (DPE) - Warwick District

Report of the Interim Strategic Director for Environment and Economy.

Proposals for various changes to parking restrictions in Warwick District have been advertised and objections have been received. The report considers the objections



and recommends how they should be dealt with. The report also includes the outcome of an initial review of the new parking management arrangements.

Recommendation

- (1) That the Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Resident's Parking) (Consolidation) (Variation No 3) Order 2007 and the Warwickshire County Council (Guys Street and Guy's Cliffe Terrace, Warwick) (Traffic Regulation) (Variation No 1) Order 2007 be made as advertised but with the following modifications:-
 - (i) Retention of the existing double yellow lines fronting No 22 Cherry Street.
 - (ii) Retention of the existing residents parking scheme in Wathen Road and Peel Road pending the outcome of the proposal in 2 (ii) below.
- (2) That the following proposals be advertised:-
 - (i) No waiting from 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday outside No's 13 to 19/21Cherry Street.
 - (ii) Waiting limited to 20 minutes except for W6 permit holders in Wathen Road, Peel Road and Percy Road
- (3) That no further action be taken in respect of providing footway parking on the north side of Guy's Cliffe Terrace and at the north end of Guy Street.
- (4) That the request for a "Home Zone" type scheme in the Guy Street/Cherry Street area be noted but that residents be advised that current resources do not permit this being given further consideration.
- (5) That further consultations be carried out with residents of Coventry Road with a view to revised proposals being developed and advertised for the parking arrangements along the road.

5. Warwick Town Centre Traffic Management Review - Progress Report

Report of the Interim Strategic Director for Environment and Economy.

This report describes the progress to date in developing schemes to manage traffic in Warwick. Much of this work has been carried out by the Forum which was established by this Committee in November 2005. The support of Committee is sought for continued work on the development and assessment of the Forum's proposed schemes. The report also discusses a consultant's report into a range of



possible complementary measures, which, taken in combination, could help deliver the Forum's Vision for Warwick.

Recommendation

That Committee supports:-

- (1) The continuing work of the Warwick Forum.
- (2) The continuing work of officers in assessing the 'street by street' proposals.
- (3) The implementation of a one-way system on Chapel Street.
- (4) Further investigation into the removal of the A429 in Warwick from the Primary Route Network.

Proposed changes to parking fees and charges across Warwick District for off street car parking across Warwick District and changes to on street car parking charges in Leamington Spa Town Centre

- (2) Approves an increase of the on-street parking charge in Leamington Spa Town Centre from £1.80 to £2.00 for a two hour stay, in line with Warwick District Council's proposed off street car park charging strategy.
