Warwickshire Police and Crime Commissioner Annual Report

Recommendation

That the Police and Crime Panel considers the Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report, asks questions in relation to its content and considers a formal collective response to the report.

1.0 Background

- 1.1 Each year, the Police and Crime Commissioner is required to produce an Annual Report which outlines the progress that has been made towards achieving the objectives set out in his Police and Crime Plan. A copy of the PCC's Annual Report for 2017/18 has been circulated separately.
- 1.2 Members of the Police and Crime Panel are asked to consider the Annual Report and form a collective response. In accordance with the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Panel is required to make a report to the PCC following the meeting which captures the Panel's view, comments and any recommendations regarding the Annual Report.
- 1.3 The Democratic Services Manager will liaise with the Chair and the Head of Law and Governance after the meeting to agree the content of the report. The report will then be sent to the PCC and published on the Panel's webpage.
