An increase of 8 Children in Care since May 2021



Children in Care Placement Type

WCC Foster Carer (inc Family and Friends carers)



348 children (40%); an increase of 6 children (+3.7%) since May

Placed for Adoption



25 children (2.9%) of all CIC at 30 June; a decrease of 1 CIC since 31 May 2021

Agency Foster Carer



225 CIC (25.8%); a decrease of 5 children (-2.2%) since May 21

Residential Establishment



83 children (9.5%); an increase of 2 children (+2.4%) since May 2021



CiC 'Missing' or 'Away from placement without authorisation'



30 children in care were missing (78 episodes)

During June 2021 there were 78 episodes of a child missing or away from their placement without authorisation. This related to 30 individual children with 13 children having multiple missing episodes during the month.


