1. Executive Summary

- 1.1 'Investment Beliefs' form a core part of the detailed Strategy Review. They set out the underlying beliefs about how the Fund should be run, and particularly how the Fund's assets should be invested. Warwickshire Pension Fund's Investment Beliefs cover both 'General Beliefs' and 'Responsible Investment Beliefs'.
- 1.2 Prior to this paper, the PFISC received training on Investment Beliefs. The current Investment Beliefs were set out in a workshop on 17 August, alongside several suggested changes from the Investment Consultants, Hymans Robertson.
- 1.3 Committee members were asked to complete a questionnaire (Appendix 1) reflecting the extent to which their views aligned with a set of statements across purpose, strategy and structure, implementation, and governance.
- 1.4 On 6 September, there is a workshop for PFISC members to discuss the outcome of this questionnaire and debate an updated set of Investment Beliefs.
- 1.5 The intention is to circulate the outcome of the 6 September workshop as a draft set of Investment Beliefs ahead of the 13 September PFISC meeting. These will be tabled virtually in advance of the meeting and published as Appendix 2 once available.
- 1.6 The purpose of this paper is to provide the PFISC with a chance to finalise the draft Investment Beliefs so that they can be used in the upcoming Strategy Review.
