Dispensations for the Warwickshire Police and Crime Commissioner

That the Warwickshire Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) for the purpose of exercising his functions in relation to emergency services collaboration may:

- (a) in cases where the PCC is an elected member or co-opted member of another public authority, or whose spouse or partner is an elected or co-opted member of another public authority, and the PCC only has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest in a matter by virtue of the fact that s/he or his/her spouse or partner is in receipt of an allowance from that other public authority then
 - i. where the issue is a matter of dispute between the County Council and the other authority, and the matter would affect the financial position of that other authority, the PCC may speak on the matter provided s/he immediately withdraws from the meeting room; and
 - ii. in relation to other matters affecting that other authority, the PCC may speak and vote.
- (b) Where the PCC only has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest in a matter relating to the County Council or another authority by virtue of the fact that his or her spouse or partner is an employee of the County Council or that other authority, the PCC may speak and vote on all matters affecting the County Council or that other authority other than issues which would have a direct impact on the employment of the spouse or partner.
