Summary of Matter

The planning consent for the new development of the Kenilworth Multi Academy Trust Kenilworth School and Sixth Form deemed that the junction of Dencer Drive and Leyes Lane should be signalised. Following advertising of these proposals several objections were received in response and to maintain the Councils obligation to provide a controlled crossing an alternative toucan crossing has been considered.

The alternative toucan crossing has been properly advertised in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 23, however further objections have been received. Due to the importance of constructing a safe crossing point for pupils attending the school which is due to open September this year an urgent decision is required to allow construction of the crossing to proceed.

Proposed Decision

The Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning approves the introduction of a toucan crossing facility which would provide pedestrian and cycling facilities as formally advertised, conditional upon the necessary Highways Act 1980, Section 278 agreement being in place.
