53.3% (427) of CiC are on a Full Care Order; this is a decrease of 5 children since 31/08/2023.

11.4% (91) of CiC are on an Interim Care Order; this is a decrease of 4 children since the previous month end.



4.4% (35) of CiC are on a Placement Order; this is an increase of 4 children since 31/08/2023.



30.6% (245) of CiC are subject to **S20 Accommodation**: this is the same number of children as the previous month end.


