Summary of matter

- Under the County Council's Constitution authority has been given to the
 relevant Portfolio Holder to approve the submission of funding bids on behalf of
 the County Council. This report seeks approval in relation to a bid to the
 Department for Transport (DfT) Local Transport Capital Block Funding Specific
 Grant Determination (2023/24) for an additional sum for upgrading traffic
 signals and the Urban Traffic Management Control System.
- On 14 May 2021 Council reconfirmed the delegated power to the Leader, or body nominated by them, to approve the addition to the Capital Programme of projects costing less than £2m which are fully funded from external grants, developer contributions or revenue. The Portfolio Holder for Finance and Property is that nominated body.
- Approval is given to bid for the Traffic Signal Obsolescence Grant for approximate value of £500,000. This will address where our greatest need is to replace our obsolescence assets and if successful add the grants to the Capital Programme for expenditure.

Proposed Decision
