12 December 2024 – Cabinet	NHSE Capital Funded Dordon Development. To provide an update on the project exploring the development of six units of supported housing for autistic people and people with a learning disability.
12 December 2024 – Cabinet	Approval to reprocure Home Care services and Residential Care. Seeking the approval to tender and to delegate responsibility to enter into relevant contracts for the procurement and provision of domiciliary care and residential care services.
28 January 2025 – Cabinet	Joint Coventry and Warwickshire Health Protection Strategy. To review the data and evidence available around health protection needs across Coventry and Warwickshire, consider areas which fall below national targets and to make appropriate recommendations to mitigate.

- 4.1 This section of the report details the areas being considered by district and borough councils at their scrutiny / committee meetings that are relevant to health and wellbeing. <b>North Warwickshire Borough Council (NWBC)</b>	
	<p>In North Warwickshire, the meeting structure is operated through a series of boards with reports to the Community and Environment Board. There is a Health and Wellbeing Working Party and a Warwickshire North Health and Wellbeing Partnership (covering both North Warwickshire and Nuneaton and Bedworth).</p> <p>From the NWBC website, the Community and Environment Board met on 14 October, there being no items linked to Health. The Health and Wellbeing Working Party met on 23 September 2024 and amongst the items considered was a 'spotlight' report on measles and whooping cough. An update from partners included WCC health related projects.</p>
<b>Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council (NBBC)</b>	
	<p>The NBBC Health and Corporate Resources OS Panel met on 24 October 2024. The agenda included no items linked to health. A suggestion was submitted to add to the work programme an item on the Blue Mental Health Support Education initiative, a teacher training initiative linked to mental health. Future planned items for this panel include updates from Healthwatch and the George Eliot Hospital.</p>
<b>Rugby Borough Council – Overview and Scrutiny Committee (OSC)</b>	
	<p>The Borough Council has a single Scrutiny Committee, which met on 19 October 2024. The Committee considered a review of its work programme. Looking at the revised programme, there are currently no items relating to health.</p>
<b>Stratford-upon-Avon District Council – Overview and Scrutiny Committee (OSC)</b>	
	<p>The District Council's OSC met on 4 October and 1 November 2024. Looking at the Committee's Work Plan, there are currently no items scheduled through to March 2025 which relate to health.</p>
<b>Warwick District Council – Overview and Scrutiny Committee (OSC)</b>	
	<p>The District Council's OSC met on 13 November and will meet again on 3 December 2024. From the work programme, no health-related</p>

scrutiny items are listed currently.
